

# Aid to Working Families

## Child Care Assistance

Eligible families can receive help with the cost of caring for children while working or in school. The Child Care Assistance for Working Families Program pays part of the cost of child care for eligible families (see chart below).

It allows you to choose a licensed child care center, school-age program, head start, child care home provider (non-relative or relative.) The amount you pay is based on your income, family size and number of children in child care.

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# Healthy Start

The Healthy Start program gives you greater control over the ups and downs of the family budget with free health insurance for your eligible children under the age of 19. Some parents and pregnant women may also be eligible depending on their income. Eligibility is determined by the number of family members at home and total household income. Check the chart below to see if your family qualifies.

In order to determine eligibility, you must provide written proof of certain information such as family income and size, pregnancy (if appropriate) and citizenship.

Children enrolled in Healthy Start receive a wide range of health care services, including:

- Regular checkups
- Dental care and treatment
- Eye care and eyeglasses
- Immunizations
- Emergency Care
- Hospitalization
- Prescriptions

Pregnant women also receive:

- Prenatal and postnatal services
