Child Care Subsidies

Now there's help with the cost of caring for your child while you're on the job or in training. The Child Care Assistance for Working Families Program pays part of the cost of child care for eligible families (see chart below). It allows you to choose a child

care center, child care home, or care by a relative or other adult, based on your family's needs. So quit worrying about missing work when you can't find a babysitter. Put your children in the child care of your choice while saving hundreds of dollars!

Healthy Start

The Healthy Start program gives you greater control over the ups and downs of the family budget with free health insurance for your children under the age of 19. Some parents and pregnant women may also be eligible depending on their income. Eligibility is determined by the number of family members at home and total house-hold income. Check the chart below to see if your family qualifies.

Children enrolled in Healthy Start receive a wide range of health care services, including:

- Regular checkups
- Dental care
- Eye Care
- Prescriptions
- Immunizations
- Emergency Care
- Hospitalization
